Accused arrested

The man awaiting trial in a fatal hit-and-run was picked up by cops for breaching a court-ordered condition this weekend.

Colin Jones is accused in the hit-and-run death of Lindsay Giacomelli, 20, who was struck in a crosswalk at Bonaventure Dr. S.E. on St. Patrick's Day this past March.

He was arrested Friday night near his Calgary home and charged with breaching a court-ordered condition and given a 24-hour driving suspension.

He was released on bail pending his next court appearance.

His criminal trial was set to start earlier this year but adjourned after the Crown agreed with a defence request to have the case moved to Court of Queen's Bench where it would be heard by a judge and jury.
