## Hit-and-run trial set

A five-day trial has been set to begin Dec. 2 for a city man charged with hit and run in the death of 20-year-old Lindsay Giacomelli on St. Patrick's Day.

Colin Jones did not appear in provincial court on Tuesday but was represented by co-counsel Lisa Burgis, who agreed to the date with Crown prosecutor Camelia Wong.

Jones, 48, was arrested March 21 in Toronto trying to board a flight to England, brought back to Calgary and granted bail three days later on \$5,000 cash or \$10,000 non-cash assets.
