## New trial date set for accused in fatal hit-run

A new trial date was set for a 48-year-old man after he pleaded not guilty Wednesday to fatally running over University of Calgary student Lindsay Giacomelli at a southeast crosswalk last St. Patrick's Day.

Colin Jones faces a four-day jury trial in Court of Queen's Bench starting on June 5.

Jones was charged with hit and run for allegedly striking Giacomelli, 20, with his vehicle in a Bonaventure Drive S.E. crosswalk on the evening of March 17, 2005.

She died the next day in Foothills hospital.

Jones was involved in another collision with a flat-bed truck in Carstairs and was arrested the following day in Toronto, after purchasing a one-way ticket to fly to Gatwick, England.
